Dear Resident,

Demolition of Aberthaw Power Station

As you are aware we are the chosen contractor to undertake the demolition works at Aberthaw Power Station.

Since our previous letter in June 2024, we have carried out various works around the site and are progressing well with our demolition management plan approved in October 2024 from the Vale of Glamorgan Council to demolish the power station.

In the last few weeks, we have begun demolition on site with the previous contractor cabins being demolished and the demolition of the dust bunker and conveyor systems currently being undertaken. Whilst demolition has been commencing, we have been soft stripping areas of the Power Station and removing transformers to prepare the areas for demolition.

Scaffolding has been erected within the boiler house, hoppers and the turbine hall to facilitate asbestos removal. Asbestos Removal is currently being undertaken within the turbine hall, boiler house, hoppers and various outbuildings on site. Our adherence to Health and Safety Executive (HSE) guidelines and the Control of Asbestos Regulations 2012 ensures the safe removal of asbestos from each building prior to demolition.

As mentioned in our previous letter we have conducted thorough ecological surveys in collaboration with environmental authorities and have now installed and relocated various bird and bat boxes.

Enhancements to site security have been implemented, including fence line improvements and the utilisation of CCTV and motion sensing equipment to safeguard the area.

We understand that demolition works may raise concerns among residents regarding noise and dust levels, but please be assured we are committed to mitigating any potential impacts. A comprehensive Noise and Vibration plan along with an air quality plan have been developed by Erith and approved by the Vale of Glamorgan Council.

We have several real-time monitoring stations located around different locations on site which will track noise, dust, and vibration levels throughout our time on site. In the event of any "spikes" in monitored levels, our site managers will promptly receive alerts, leading to an immediate review and any necessary adjustments being made following assessment.
