## **Demolition of Aberthaw Power Station**

Since our last update in November 2024, we are pleased to report continued progress on site.

Works within Zone 5 of the site are on track for completion in September 2025, at which point the area will be ready for handover to CCR Energy.

Zone 5 is shown on the diagram below.

Demolition activities within the turbine hall are progressing steadily. The removal of redundant plant and equipment is being carried out using the overhead gantry cranes. We anticipate completion of these works by October 2025.

We are actively processing and crushing the arisings from Zone 5. This material is being recycled and stored on site for reuse on various areas of the site as our works progress.

Maintaining the highest standards of health, safety and environmental protection remains a top priority during our works. Regular noise, dust and vibration monitoring continues to be in place to ensure all site activities are being delivered withing regulated thresholds.

We are proud to be able to support a variety of local community initiatives whilst we are on site.

This year we have contributed in the following ways:

- Donated a new defibrillator to the East Aberthaw Community, now part of the British Heart Foundations national network.
- Provided support and donations to the Vale Foodbank, helping them reach more individuals and families in need.
- Contributed to Horatio's Garden Wales which provides support to those requiring rehabilitation care that have experienced spinal cord injuries.
- Donated to the Academy of Barmy Composers, enabling them in delivering music training to six local schools.
- Supplied two shelters to St. Athan's Football Club.
- Supported the NCI (National Coast watch Institution) in repairing a broken camera at St. Donat's
  Bay along with supplying and installing a brand-new camera improving coastal visibility and safety
  monitoring.
