Demolition of Aberthaw Power Station

Dear Resident,

Since our last update in November 2025, works within Zones 1, 2 and 3 have continued to progress.

Preparation and detailed planning for the demolition of the turbine hall is well underway. It is anticipated that controlled explosive demolition will take place within the next two weeks. This method has been carefully chosen and extensively planned by qualified explosive and demolition engineers to ensure precision, safety, and minimal disruption to the surrounding community.

The safety of the public and our workforce remain our highest priority. Comprehensive planning and risk assessments have been carried out in advance of the demolition.

The public coastal path, and some local roads, around the power station will be temporarily closed for a short duration whilst the explosive event is taking place - these areas are included within our exclusion zone. Trained traffic marshals will be positioned at these closures to notify members of the public of diversions and when it will be safe to reopen. Closures will be in place for a short time to keep disruptions to local residents at a minimum.

We understand that explosive demolition may raise concerns among residents, particularly regarding noise, dust and vibration levels. Please be assured we are committed to mitigating any potential impacts and all reasonable measures will be taken. The demolition will generate a loud noise; however, this will be short in duration. Noise, dust, and vibration monitoring will be in operation throughout these works along our boundary lines.

Health, safety, and environmental protection continues to be our top priority. We are working closely with the emergency services and relevant authorities to ensure all arrangements are in place.

Following the completion of these works, CCR Energy will provide an update on their website to confirm the activity has taken place. Residents are encouraged to refer to the website for the most up to date information.
