Demolition of Aberthaw Power Station

Dear Resident,

Since our last update in June 2026, demolition works at Aberthaw Power Station have continued to progress safely and as planned.

We would like to inform residents that the next controlled explosive demolition, involving the Boiler House and GT Stack, is planned for 2nd of October with a contingency date of the 6th of October, subject to suitable weather and site conditions.

The demolition will be carried out by specialist demolition and explosive engineers using a carefully planned method designed to ensure safety, precision, and minimal disruption to the local community.

The safety of residents, members of the public, and our workforce remains our highest priority. Detailed planning and risk assessments are being completed in coordination with emergency services, relevant authorities, and specialist contractors.

To ensure the area remains safe during the demolition:

- Limpert Bay Road and sections of the public coastal path surrounding the site will be closed for a short period.
- South Wales Police will be present at the temporary closures, alongside trained security and demolition personnel at access points and diversion routes.
- Access will be restored as soon as the area has been confirmed safe.

We recognise that explosive demolition may cause concern for nearby residents. The event will produce a short, loud noise, similar to a loud thunderclap, as the structures are brought down. Any noise associated with the demolition itself will be brief, lasting only a few seconds.

To minimise impacts:

- Dust suppression measures will be in operation before, during, and after the demolition.
- Noise, dust, and vibration monitoring equipment will operate throughout the works.
- Environmental monitoring will continue around the site boundary during the activity.
